Now, I have converted QB to PDF, and I am viewing that PDF, when I am clicking the validation icon at the top of the screen, I get nothing! I can see some parts of the page however. Could someone please help me with validation codes I can use? A: I have also run into this issue as of today, It seems like they were having a hard time getting the watermark to work for web-based edition of qb. You can however export the file as a pdf and then add watermark then re-add the file. Here are the steps I am taking right now. 1.) First make sure the page is in edit mode 2.) Select the validation icon and click the export as pdf. 3.) You can change the name of the file if you want. 4.) Open the file and add the watermark. 5.) Export the file back to qb and click the 'add to invoice' icon. 6.) You should see the file in the list of files that you can add to the invoice.
